



Are you an HIV-positive mother who would like to know your baby's HIV status?

Take action and test your baby for HIV at your nearest clinic at six-weeks.

If the clinic is using point-of-care early infant HIV diagnosis (POC EID) technology, you will **get your test results the same day.**

If your baby is HIV-negative, ask when you should take the next test and how to make sure your baby stays well.

If your baby is HIV-positive, it is important to begin antiretroviral treatment immediately to ensure survival and health.

Consult your health care provider about treatment management and start treatment on the day you receive your child's status result.
