Question 1:

Pricing would be the same, but this stock is better for purposes of the print run. Are we allowed to provide customizable options for each line item?

Answer:

Absolutely! If you have suggestions for stock or other specifics that would improve the final products outlined in our scenarios that would be similarly priced, we would be happy to hear your thoughts and suggestions.

Question 2:

Are you requesting 3 referrals for each of the three scenarios, or 1 referral for each of the three scenarios?

Answer:

Question 3:

How many unique samples are you requesting for each scenario?

Answer:

You are requesting that the proposal be distilled to one page. Does that mean that it is acceptable to provide just a dollar figure for each scenario rather than a complete letter of quote for each?

A dollar figure for each scenario is fine though it would also be helpful to know if delivery is included within the quoted price.
