- 1.1. This RFP was prepared by Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation (EGPAF) and being issued to selected suppliers on the clear understanding that its contents are strictly confidential and as such may not be given to any third party without a prior express permission of EGPAF.
- 1.2. The specifications prescribed are not in any way limited to any specific tenderer as they are based on generally achievable requirements.
- 1.3. EGPAF does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender price and reserves the right to reject all submissions, in whole or in part, enter into negotiations with any party, and/or award multiple contracts.
- 1.5. Tenders **MUST** be received on or before the **closing date** and **time** and all bids received after the closing date and time will not be considered.
- 1.6. The quotation **MUST** include the following:
  - 1.6.1. Bid Validity Date.
  - 1.6.2. Unit Price and Total Price including taxes. No submission will be considered for any discovered omissions from the tenderer (s).
- 1.6.3. Prices to be quoted in **XAF all taxes included.**
- 1.7. No advance payment shall be affected.
- 1.8. The successful bidder will be issued with a Contract.
- 1.9. Any costs associated with the preparation and subsequent submission of a quotation shall remain the sole responsibility of the supplier irrespective of the outcome of the final selection process.

The bidder receiving the highest score will be considered the Best Value and will be awarded the contract.
