



# The Pediatric HIV Treatment Gap

\*As of 2024



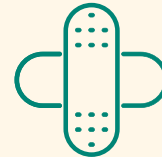
**120,000 children**  
were newly infected with HIV.



Without timely treatment,  
**50% of HIV-positive infants**  
**die before age two.**



**150,000 new infections in**  
**adolescents** (15-19 years), 66% of  
which were among girls.



**~2.42 million children**  
aged 0-19 are living with HIV.



**75,000 children (<15) died**  
from AIDS-related, equating to roughly  
200 deaths daily.



**Only 55% of children living**  
**with HIV** receive antiretroviral  
therapy, leaving ~620,000 untreated.



HIV positive children are  
**six times more likely to die**  
than adults without early diagnosis.



Sub-Saharan Africa accounts for  
**88% of children living with HIV,**  
**83% of new infections, and**  
**84% of AIDS-related deaths.**
